Lynn Johnson stated we can pay to have the flyers printed. Lynn Johnson will take care of shopping and registration. Cody Armand will be the ride chairman. Tony Boudreau volunteered to be a SAG leader. Mike Porter volunteered for rolling SAG. Cody is arranging for Scouts to help with SAG. Bruce Wickert usually is over ride starts. Cody and Lynn will oversee swag. \$10 will be added for walk up registration. We will add an option for lunch for \$10 for non-participants. If parking is an issue, Scouts will assist. Cody inquired about printing t-shirts for the ride with both BRBC and Scouts logos. We decided to order four of each size to sell the day of the ride. Cody and Lynn will paint the route.
